Using the Ribbon Rose tool by Carrie Lourenco

Place the silk ribbon thru the open eye of the rose tool, with a small tail extending out beyond the tool.

Make a loop and glue it together

Apply a tiny bit of glue to the ribbon base. Roll the ribbon onto itself making the bud part of the rose. (about 2-3 turns)

Now fold the ribbon back against it self, and continue to gently twist the ribbon tool toward you,.

Apply a dab of glue at the base then..

Roll the folded area of the ribbon toward you (See the petal) Secure the petal with your finger over the glue

Continue folding the ribbon back on itself, applying small amounts of glue at the base and turning the tool towards yourself. Press the base with your thumb to hold each petal turn.

When you have as full a rose as you want, simply glue down the end of the ribbon to the base of the rose and cut off the excess. Slide the rose off your rose tool and allow to dry before handling.
